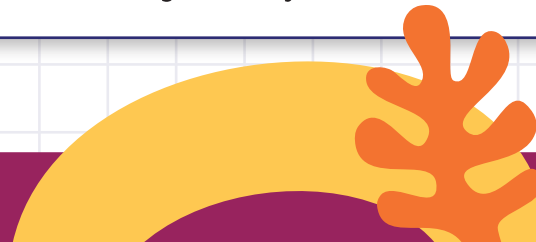

(1 Year 7 Months - 2 Year 7 Months)

## Curriculum

### Focus Areas

Basic motor skills development, sensory exploration, and social interaction.

### Activities

Play-based activities, music and movement, simple art projects, and sensory play.

### Study Goals

Develop fine motor skills through activities like stacking blocks, finger painting, and playing with simple puzzles.

### Step-by-Step Progress

Encourage sensory development through activities involving different textures, colors, and sounds.

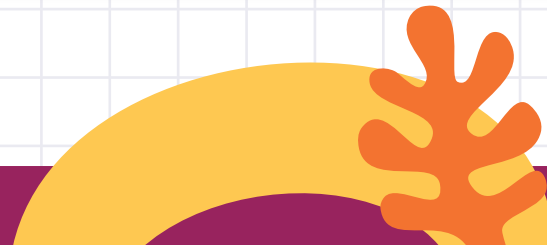
Foster social skills through parallel play, simple group activities, and interactive games.

Month 1-3: Introduction to the classroom environment, basic routines, and socializing.

Enhance vocabulary through stories, rhymes, and interactive conversations.

Encourage cooperative play, sharing, and turn-taking.

Introduce basic thematic role play activities.

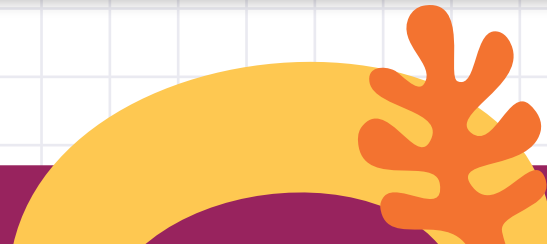
### Step-by-Step Progress

Introduce phonics and basic reading skills through interactive stories.

Build on counting skills and introduce basic addition and subtraction.

Focus on empathy, communication, and problem-solving.

Engage in more complex role play scenarios with a focus on cooperation and creativity.

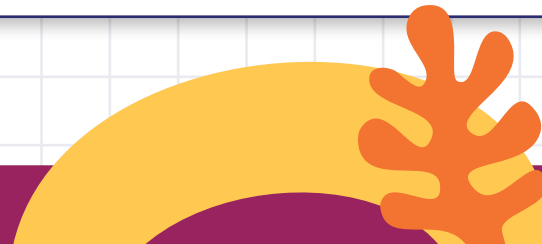
### **Step-by-Step Progress**

Foster leadership, teamwork, and effective communication.

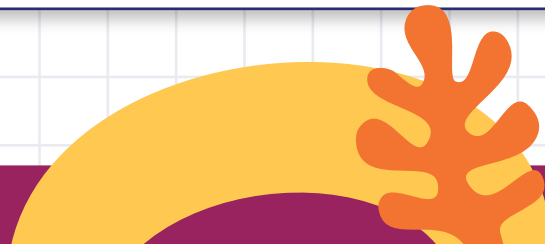
### **Step-by-Step Progress**
