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EARLY CHILDHOOD SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT

DEFINITION OF SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT

Assessment is the process of collecting and processing information to determine the learning needs and developmental achievements or learning outcomes of students. Important information is presented chronologically. Summative assessment is carried out to ensure the achievement of all learning objectives. Assessment strategies in PAUD must pay attention to child development, the child's social conditions, the learning environment and so on.

PAUD assessment reports are in the form of learning achievement reports plus information on student growth and development.





The Function of Summative Assessment at the Early Childhood Education Level

- 1. To find out the achievement of student learning outcomes in a certain period.
- 2. To compare the achievement of student learning outcomes with the established indicators.
- 3. To provide information about the student concerned to parents/ guardians.



Assessment can be done using several techniques that can be adjusted by educators. For example, using observations that are carried out continuously through periodic behavioral observations. If the assessment results show that students are not yet able to, then the teacher can determine the right method or action to prepare students. The results of this evaluation can also be used to determine enrichment programs or special assistance that may be needed for children/ In addition, parents can also develop appropriate learning strategies that are in accordance with the needs of their children. This certainly makes the learning process in the future better.
